

Services You Might Receive

If you have had your needs assessed it does not automatically follow that you will be eligible for support from social care. This is dependent on the level of your needs and the criteria used by each local authority as to who they will support.

The services you are offered in response to your assessment may be:

- + Information, advice, guidance and advocacy
- + Counselling
- + Befriending services and help to socialise and meet people
- + Signposting to other statutory services
- + Signposting to local mainstream or voluntary sector activities
- + Support to look for employment, education or training opportunities
- + Housing and accommodation: Support to live independently, Support with specialist housing or Full time support in a residential home
- + Help to manage money or apply for benefits
- + Signposting to preventative mental health services
- + Promotion of well-being
- + Prevention/delay of development of needs
- + Help with the criminal justice system, police matters and probation services
